Every summer, the W. Dale Brougher YMCA of the Roses comes alive with laughter, adventure, and discovery!



The rates listed above include before/after care which secures your child care from 7:00am to 6:00pm. The registration fee is a one time fee due at registration and is non-refundable. Camp families can pick and choose which weeks their campers attend and are only responsible for payments for those weeks. *Two weeks notice is required for cancellation, without proper notice both weeks will be charged.*

DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE

Family Membership, 10% Sibling, and Scholarship Financial Assistance discounts are available. Camp families may only utilize one of the discounts options listed. The camp director can provide assistance/feedback based on a family's specific needs to which discount is the best to utilize. Financial Aid applications must be received two weeks prior to the start of camp to ensure processing.

FIELD TRIPS

SWIMMING
